## Additional note – Wine or Grape Juice ?

In Hebrew language, wine is "YAYIN" meaning PREAVENCE - BUBLING. The word's picture language too represents the same. Bubbling is the visible sign of fermented grape juice. "Unfermented Grape Juice" was not known till Louis Pasieur around 1862 A.D discovered pasteurization method to prevent fermentation process. Hence, Biblical wine is not plain grape juice, as popularly believed. Israel's Wine used for sacred occasions had less than 3% of alchohol.

## II Thessalonians 3:6

"Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition which he received of us."

- This is a general statement in a specific context
- Some contend that this command only applies to this specific context (i.e., to those who refuse to work - v. 11).
  - Note II Thess. 3:14 "And if any man obey not our word by this epistie, note that man, and have no company with him, that he may be ashamed."
- What is in "this epistle"?
  - If Thess. 2:15 "Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word(s), or our epistle(s)."
  - If Thess, 3:4 "And we have confidence in the Lord buching you, that ye both do and will do the things which we command you."
